4. 1 box and 1 tray for Pharaoh expansion
5. 1 box for plastic monuments

CORE GAME BOX CONTENTS AND LAYOUT

Core game box contains all Gods components, common game components, Pharaoh Expansion, guardian miniatures from core game box, rulebooks, original paper game boards in order to allow to play the game in its entirety only using core game box (guardian figures should be in this case replaced by figures from the core game using expansion cards). Pantheon box contains components of the game, that bring nicer appearance (expansion guardian figures, plastic monuments, cardboard game boards)



Boxes for Gods components

- lower tray for God figure, slots for Warrior figures, Priest miniatures (3 slots marked with a letter P)
- top tray for Ankh token, battle cards, unique components for specific God (if any)
- top tray is stored in a cut out part of the lower tray
- most boxes have a layout similar to the Amun box above
- in order to fit various miniatures of various sizes, please observe in next pictures layout of components in each God box

Lower part of box for Bastet God stores also miniatures of cats

Boxes for general game components

- box for camels, follower tokens, conflict order tokens
- box for paper monument tokens
- box for guardian cards (all guardian cards)
- box for merged gods
- all four boxes are assembled into one black box for storage (see next pictures)

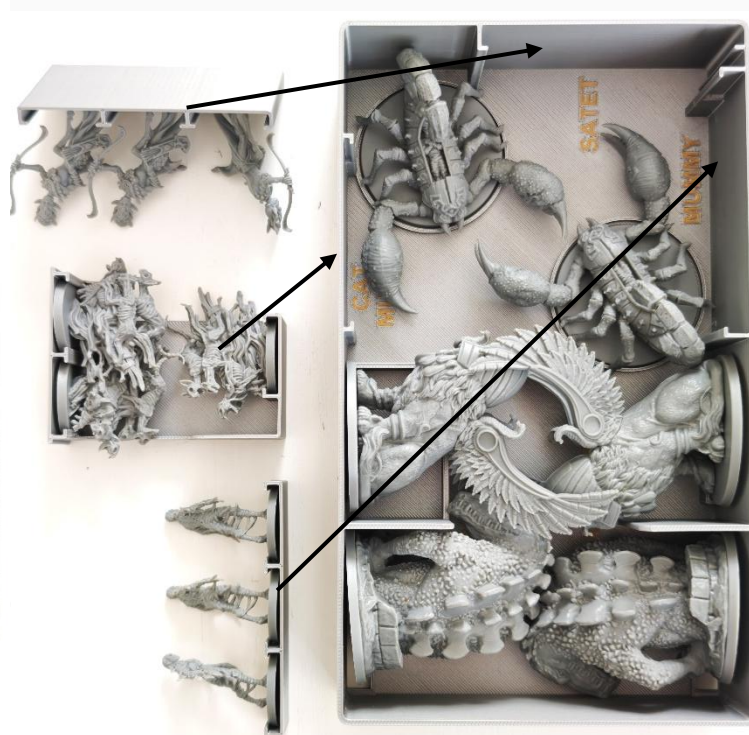


Box for setup components

Pharaoh box



- contains all Pharaoh expansion components except priests, which are stored in respective God boxes
- fits paper and plastic sphinx miniatures
- separate box for cards
- upper box, containing cards fits into lower box



Box for Guardian figures from core game box

- stores all Guardian miniatures from core game box
- holders for Mummy, Cat Mummy and Satet guardians can be removed from the Guardians box to facilitate easy removal

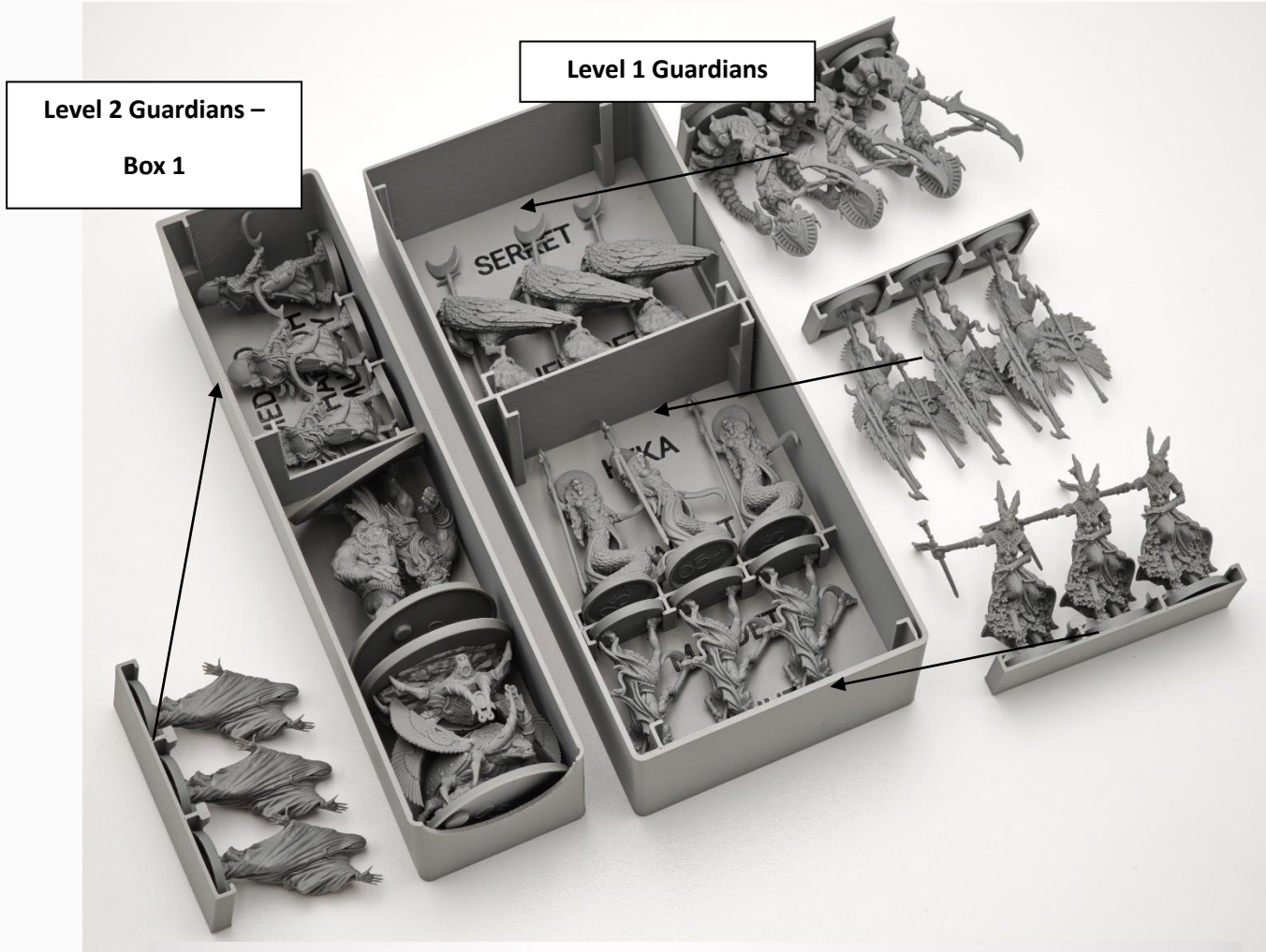


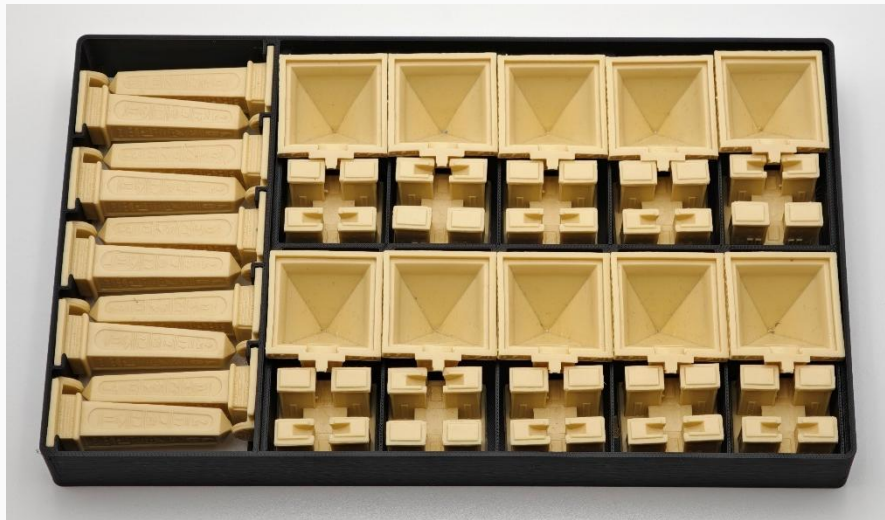
Boxes and trays inside the core game box (game boards and rulebooks not shown) – Lower deck and upper deck. Tail of Sobek God protrudes into box of Anubis God box. All 12 God dashboards fit into recessed part of the two decks of boxes – Pharaoh box, Common components box and Guardians box are lower then Amun and Isis boxes. Please see next picture:



PANTHEON BOX CONTENTS AND LAYOUT

Pantheon box contains all guardian miniatures from Guardians Set box and Tomb of Wonders box, plastic monuments (except sphinxes), merged god plinth and all cardboard game boards. Guardian figures are divided in boxes based on level of Guardians (level one – 1 box, level 2 – two boxes, level 3 – 1 box). Following pictures show layout of guardians in corresponding boxes. Some of the guardians are in separate holders to allow access without taking out miniatures one by one to get to the lower deck.





Box for plastic monuments

- pyramids are stored upside down
- empty space below obelisk miniatures serves to accommodate Bennu guardian miniature, which protrudes from the guardians box. It is therefore necessary to place monuments box in the Pantheon box according to following picture:





Petsuchos box and merged god plinth box

Next pictures show placement of components in Pantheon box.





Components of the game and expansions can fit inside with about 1cm deck lift. Game box can be stored vertically when tightly closed.
